And whereas it is necessary to declare the aims and objects of the public charitable trust, being constituted under these presents.

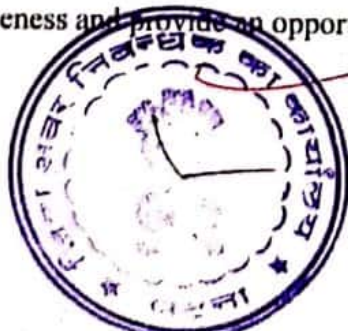
2) Now this indenture witnessed as follows:

That, in order to effectuate his aforesaid desire, the settler has set apart and handed over to the trustees, a sum of Rs. 50,000/- (Rupees Fifty thousand) (hereinafter called the "Trust Fund" which expression shall include cash and any other property of investments of any kind whatsoever into which the same or any part thereof might be converted, invested or varied from time to time which may be acquired by the trustees or may come to their hands by virtue of these presents or by operation of law or otherwise howsoever in relation to these presents), and the trustees shall hold and stand possessed of the same upon the trust subject to the powers, provisions, agreements and declarations hereinafter contained.

That the name of the trust shall be "SUTARA'S SOCIAL IMPOWERMENT MISSION", Registered Office will be House No. 1145, Bailey Road, Opposite Rupaspur P.S., P.S.- Rupaspur, District - Patna and/or at such other place or places as the trustees may decide from time to time.

3. **That the objects for which this trust is established are :**

[A.] To promote the saving habits of people and ensure maximum benefit to the people of mass through the saving promotion, cost-effectiveness and provide an opportunity to prepare various

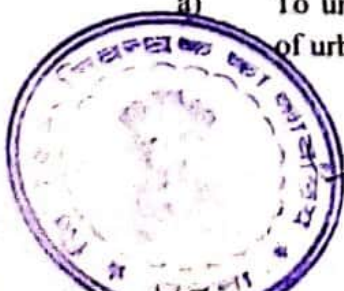

All the incomes, earnings, movable/immovable properties of the trust shall be solely utilized and applied towards the promotion of its Aims and Objects only as set forth in the deed of the trust and no profit thereof shall be paid or transferred directly or indirectly by way of dividends, bonus, profits or in any manner whatsoever to the present or the past member of the trust or to any person claiming through any one or more of the present or the past members. No members of the trust shall have any personal claim on any movable or immovable properties of the trust or make any profits, ~~whatsoever~~, by virtue of his membership.
6. That the Trust Fund may be augmented ^{by} the income from the initial fund and also by donations and other contribution from time to time.
7. That the Trust Fund shall not be applied for any purpose other than those specified in Para 3 herein above unless the other objects added to the trust objectives.
8. That the Trustees shall always maintain proper accounts of the Trust, which shall be kept at the office of the trust.
9. 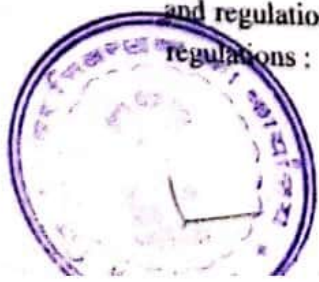

Departments, public and other bodies corporations, companies or persons, scheme and other work and matters within the objects of the Trust and to put to any proper condition upon which such grants and other payments may be made.

- (xv) To take over or amalgamate with any other charitable, trust, trustee, association, or institution with similar objects.
- (xvi) To take over, acquire, manage, control or aid any existing institution or institutions having objects either wholly or in part similar to the objects of this Trust and on such terms and conditions as may be through expedient.
- (xvii) To purchase or otherwise acquire and undertake all or any part of the property, assets, liabilities and engagement of any or more of the trusts, societies, institutions or associations with which this Trust is authorized to amalgamate.

11. The Trustees shall be accountable only for such money, and funds, which will actually come into their hands.

 - If he is requested to resign by 3/4th or as near thereto as possible of the remaining trustees.
15. Every Trustee will be at liberty to resign on giving one month's notice of his intention to do so.

18. The Trust and the Trust funds shall be irrevocable for all the times.

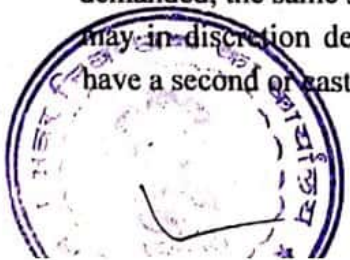


